CHECKBACK STAYMAN

by Barbara Seagram & Alex Kornel

Checkback Stayman occurs after a one-of-a-minor opening bid – a one-of-a-major response and then the opening bidder jumps to two no trump:

1 ♠ - 1 ♥
2 NT - 3 ♣ by responder is now
Checkback Stayman

Why are we doing this?

The opening bidder may have four cards in the other major suit OR may have three-card support for the responder's five-card major. We never want to miss an eight-card major suit fit. Remember that it is usually safer to play the hand in a major suit than in no trumps when you have found an eight-card fit.

Let's have a look at our auction again:

1 ♠ - 1 ♥
2 NT - 3 ♣

The responses to three clubs are as follows:

3 ♠ says: I do not have three-card support for your major, suit nor do I have four cards in the other major.

3 ♥ says: I have three-card support for your heart suit but I do NOT have four spades.

3 ♠ says: I have a four-card spade suit but do not have three-card support for your heart suit.

3 NT says: I have both three-card support for hearts and also a four-card spade suit.

Now let's check out the other major-suit situation:

1 ♠ - 1 ♠
2 NT - 3 ♣

The responses to three clubs in this instance are as follows:

3 ♠ says: I do not have three-card support for your major suit, nor do I have four cards in the other major.

3 ♥ says: I have a four-card heart suit but do not have three-card support for your spade suit.

3 ♠ says: I have three-card support for your spade suit but I do NOT have four hearts.

3 NT says: I have both three-card support for spades and also a four card heart suit.

There are two other relevant auction after which a three-club response is Checkback Stayman. They are:

1 ♣ - 1 ♥
2 NT - 3 ♣

and

1 ♣ - 1 ♠
2 NT - 3 ♣

Notice that, playing this convention, three clubs is still Checkback Stayman, NOT club support.

The only times you would use this convention are if you have :

- * 4-4 in the majors
- * 4-5 in the majors
- * one five-card major.

IRISH CRYSTAL

Selena and John Swanson of Mechanicsburg, PA are frequent attendees at the Bermuda Regional. The following hand, which was published, among other places, in the Las Vegas Daily Bulletin last summer, describes their favourite bridge hand.

Several decades ago, my wife and I traveled to Ireland with a group of 40 American bridge players. We were there to play in the Irish Bridge Classic, a bridge tournament hosted by the Irish Bridge Association. Section-top prizes were embossed Irish lead-crystal glasses. While we were much less-experienced players then, we very much wanted to win a least one section top, to have a souvenir of our trip.

Alas, the final day of the tournament arrived, and we were still without a section win. In the final event, we were determined to try our best. We were playing well with many good results. The last round arrived and we felt our game had been good enough to win. Therefore, I hoped for only innocuous hands with which to finish. That wasn't to be, as this was the final deal:

When East opened two clubs, I decided to muddy the waters by bidding two spades. West passed and my wife jumped to four spades. I thought I had just committed suicide. East doubled, a bid that reverberated throughout the room. Look what happened:

West lead the six of diamonds, which I won with the ace. The queen of clubs was covered by the king and

ruffed. I led a low heart, ruffed in dummy. The club jack was covered by the ace and ruffed. I ruffed another heart with dummy's spade eight and cashed the ten of clubs, discarding a diamond. The nine of clubs was led and East ruffed with the spade ten and I overruffed with my ace. A third heart was ruffed in dummy with the spade nine.

When I led the eight of clubs, East ruffed, and so I discarded my last diamond. East drew two rounds of trumps, but I was left with a long trump and the good jack of hearts, making four spades doubled. So, we finally got our section top and our souvenir Irish lead-crystal glasses. Ireland, what a beautiful country. We even kissed the Blarney Stone.

John Swanson of Mechanicsburg PA has advanced to Platinum Life Master, a rank that requires 10,000 master points. He and wife Selena won the national Ace of Clubs race for 2005 in the Emerald Life Master category. The two claim to be one of the few married couples who play together without yelling at each other.

Swanson is often confused with many-times national champion John Swanson of California. So much so that Marshall Miles once called him to play in the Spingold Knockout Teams! He is a graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy. While there, U.S. presidential hopeful John McCain was in his company and roomed across the hall from him. Swanson is now a retired Navy Captain.

This deal arose in the third round of yesterday morning's Swiss Teams.

Dealer South. Both Vul.

1. Roman Key Card Blackwood

3. I have no idea what I'm doing, partner, I hope you do!
4. I have no idea either!
5. Okay, maybe you have a void since we appear to be off two aces.

How would you play six spades on the seven of trumps lead? East will follow with the jack.

If you can guess who has the ace of hearts, you can lead a heart through that hand, presenting him with a Morton's Fork: he can beat the air with the ace of hearts, giving you two tricks in the suit, or duck and have you discard dummy's second heart on the ace-king of diamonds.

Suppose you play the spade ten at trick one, East plays the jack and you win the queen. You play a heart to the king, which unfortunately loses to the ace, and the six of spades is returned, South discarding a heart. Now what?

Although there is no longer a complete cross-ruff available, you still have numerous options available:

1. diamonds could be 4-3
2. the club ace might ruff out
3. multiple squeeze possibilities.

You can ruff two clubs before trying the ruffing finesse, then try diamonds. So you win the spade in dummy and ruff a club, then play ace, king and third diamond ruffing. East shows out on the third diamond, pitching a heart.

This is the position:

♠ A K
 ♥ 10
 ♦ —
 ♣ K Q 10

♠ 8 5
 ♥ Q 7
 ♦ 9 6
 ♣ —

Had it been West who'd shown out in diamonds, you'd have had the choice of a double squeeze if he had the club ace (East in diamonds, West in clubs, both in hearts), but no such squeeze is possible now. So you lead the king of clubs for a ruffing finesse and make your slam when East has that card. Well done. Plus 1430.

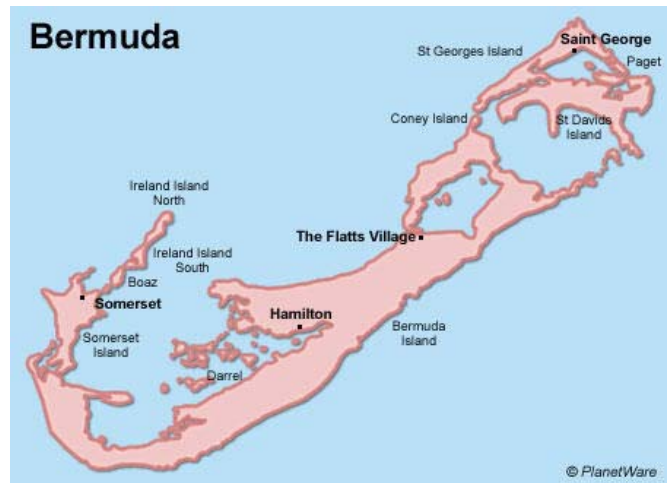

Bermuda Geology

Marine geologists say that 100 million years ago, this hook-shaped chain of little islands was part of the lip of a huge volcano, now long dormant. The submarine mount on which we're perched rises 15,000 feet from the bottom of the sea. That part of Bermuda that is above the surface of the sea is surrounded by a wide platform of underwater coral reefs that protect us from stormy weather. This shallow platform gives our inshore seas colours that you



won't soon forget – stunning blues and greens that lap at the pink sand of our beaches.

Known as the Islands of Bermuda, it is actually made up of 181 islands, islets and rocks some of which have been filled in over the years. Eight of the larger islands are linked by bridges and a causeway creating the illusion of one island.

In reality, Bermuda is the second most remote island in the world - located in the North Atlantic Ocean, 32 20 N, 64 45 W, with the nearest point of land being to the west, at Cape Hatteras, North Carolina, 650 miles (1046 km) away. New York City is 750 miles (1215 km) to the northwest and London is 3,460 miles (5568 km) to the northeast.

Many people make the mistake of thinking Bermuda's somewhere in the Caribbean. It's not. Bermuda is actually 950 miles (1529 km) to the north of Nassau, Bahamas. Bermuda is one of the smallest territories in the world; only Monaco and Gibraltar are tinier.
