BRIDGE SPREES WIN IN THREES

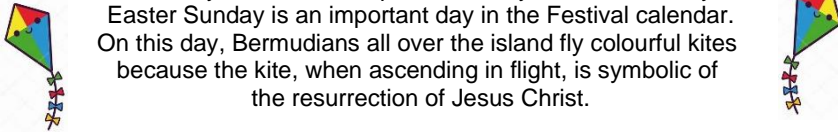
In a Bridge Sprees Group related competition spanning five days, there finally emerged a triumvirate of champions.

BERMUDAFULLY YOURS, TRADITIONALLY or Kites, Cricket, and Crown and Anchor

Traditionally, Bermuda is a predominantly Christian society so Easter Sunday is an important day in the Festival calendar. On this day, Bermudians all over the island fly colourful kites because the kite, when ascending in flight, is symbolic of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.



In local Bridge-speak, however, the expression "flying high as kites" can assume a distinctly un-holy connotation, especially in the context of swilling Swizzles or downing Dark n Stormies!

Of all Bermuda's national holidays, Cup Match is one of the most exuberant. Held on the Thursday and Friday before the first Monday in August, this fiesta show-cases a two-day cricket match between Somerset and St. George's, staged at one end of the Island or the other against a backdrop of uninhibited partying.

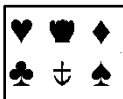
And lest our North American Bridge playing friends think that they have little in common with this most enigmatic of pastimes (cricket, that is, not uninhibited partying!), they should check out the following comments from a selection of international cricket commentators to know that, on so many levels, there's really not that much difference between the two games after all.

This game is physically and mentally soul-destroying!
You almost run out of expletives for this man's playing!
Once again, our consistency has proved to be inconsistent!
I suspect she has the I.Q. of an empty swimming pool!
Other than mistakes, they haven't put a foot wrong!
That's another nail in what looked like being a very good score!
And it's time for a glass of something chilled!

During this annual Cup Match holiday, if you happen upon a group of people huddled noisily in a corner, cricket furthest from their minds, then more likely than not they will be indulging in another of Bermuda's traditional pastimes - the game of Crown and Anchor, a simple dice game, originating in the 18th century and legalized by the Bermuda Government only for this holiday. Three special dice are used, equal in size and shape to standard dice, but instead of one through six pips, they are marked with six symbols: crown, anchor, diamond, spade, club and heart (you might be familiar with these last four!)

The game is played between a player and a banker on a mat such as the one pictured at the bottom of the page. The player places bets on one or more symbols. He then throws the three dice. If there is a bet on any symbol which comes up on one or more of the dice, the banker pays the player the amount of his stake for each die showing that symbol: even money if one, 2:1 if two, and 3:1 if three. If the symbol doesn't come up, the player loses his bet. For those of you interested in the odds - on average, the player will win 92.1% of the amount he bets; that is, over time he will lose 7.9% of whatever he bets. Thus, the banker has a substantial edge. In a game at a festival or in a casino, the house will be banker; in a game among friends, each person might serve as banker in turn.

Take the excitement generated by a game of Crown and Anchor, turn up the volume of leather on willow, add a heaping of hot summer sun, drizzle liberally with dark 'n' stormies, and top with Bermudian friendship and fun. Then Cup Match truly runneth over for all.

Bridge teachers love to give challenging hands to their students and see how they think about solving problems. This is the case for Gail Greenberg and Jeff Hand, the winner of tonight's Stratified Championship Pairs.

Gail and Jeff gave this hand to their students and asked them if on a ♦ lead, can they see a way to make 6♥? After some hard work, Hope Furth from Westchester, New York spoke up and said "I've got it!"

West leads the ♦5 against 6♥. You must win the Ace. Now you can play ♠A and ruff a ♠. If you cross back to the dummy with the ♥K and ruff another ♠, setting the ♠ up, the problem is that dummy is left with only small trump and you cannot get back there.

Here is the amazing play that Hope saw: win the ♦A at trick 1. Play ♠A and ruff a ♠, but not with the ♥5 - - you must keep it. Now lead the ♥5 and let West win their ♥6. They are the safe hand and have no more ♦, which you know from the auction and the spot card on opening lead. Now they must either play a ♠ or a ♣, which you can ruff in the dummy and now gain another entry (both plays allow you to ruff out and make use of the ♠ suit).

The key to this hand is to recognize that you are desperate and to think about how you can get the opponents to help you accomplish your goals, i.e. getting to the dummy!

Well done Hope, in figuring this out! And well done Gail and Jeff – both as teachers and players!
