Winners of yesterday afternoon's Newcomer Pairs was the local couple of Martha Ferguson and Mark Crampton. Well done to them.



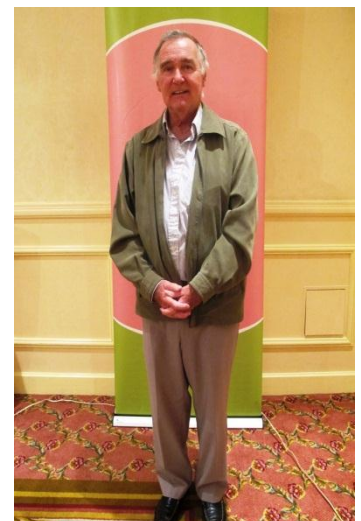
Susan and Curt Lemkau do it again with a victory in yesterday evening's Newcomer Pairs. Congratulations!

LOCAL LORE/ BERMUDA BITS (RE-RUN from 2011)

Although not endemic to Bermuda, the Longtail has been adopted as the Island's national bird and is for locals a harbinger of Spring. Longtails arrive after spending the winter at sea on the open ocean and nest with mates with whom they are paired for life. They raise a single chick during the summer months and then the family leaves again in the fall. Abundant on the Southern shore of the island in summer they are certainly among the most graceful and elegant of Bermuda's natural attractions. Ladies, look out for Longtail jewellery and grab it before it **flies off** the shelves (geddit?).

LOCAL LORE/BERMUDA BITS (NEW for 2012)

The Bermuda Bridge Club as an organization was founded in 1932 and bridge was played at various locations on the Island until, in 1974, under the then Club President Grant Horneffer, work was begun on the Clubhouse on Pomander Road in Paget. Partly financed by the members in the form of donations and interest-free debentures (see today's In the Spotlight), and since then developed and maintained by their generosity and hard work, the Clubhouse has always held a special place in the hearts of Bermuda's bridge players.



Such affection was exemplified at the outset when Grant Horneffer, in Churchillian fashion, declared,: "This clubhouse will be built if I have to do it with my own bare hands" (a plaque bearing these words hangs to this day in the Clubhouse), and then later when a subsequent Club President, who was a dab hand with emulsion, sobbed that it was his very own " *@#?!%* Sistine Chapel" (there is no plaque bearing these words – anywhere!).

Members past and present have gone to extraordinary lengths to protect and preserve the building. On one occasion, while blundering through the bushes allegedly in search of the Clubhouse boundaries, mild mannered Dr Ian Harvey surprised a gang of youths up to no good at the back door. With no thought for his own safety, our hero shouted a sharp, "Shoo!" and waved wildly in the air with the tea towel on which he had been kneeling to protect his flannels, whereupon the gang simply melted away. Whether they were ACTUALLY carrying a bag marked "SWAG", as the daredevil doctor later claimed, could not afterwards be established with any certainty, but in that bygone age when a pursed lip and a wagged finger could vanquish villains, it is entirely possible.

On another occasion, after a particularly lively party the night before, this very Bulletin Editor surprised the glamorous Jean Johnson gamely vacuuming the clubhouse carpet, awkwardly wielding the unfamiliar apparatus in designer rubber gloves, presumably to insulate her against the shock of such unaccustomed housework!

The history of the Bermuda Bridge Club has been chequered, often reflecting the social tensions of the times; Agnes Manners, for example, was deemed not to have any at all (manners, that is) and was drummed out of the club for slurping her afternoon tea too loudly; such a situation now seems laughable – the more noise you make when you drink these days, the more likely you are to be voted on to some management committee or another.

In the first session of the Wednesday –Thursday Evening Championship Pairs I faced an interesting Matchpoint problem. My partner opened a Precision 2♣ bid (showing 10-15 HCP and 6+♣.) I was amazed to hear this because I was looking at an absolute Monster of a hand. I was certain we were to make slam but I still had a lot of choices ahead of me to determine, like what level and what strain to play in.

The first decision was to just jump to 7♥ or not. That would be a very reasonable thing to do given my hand and what my partner promised. I decided that action was giving up too easily and just guessing. I figured that I was going to bid a grand slam and that I wanted to try for it in Notrump.

If I keycard in ♣ and partner has only 1 Keycard I will not know if this is the Ace or the King – and I will not know if 7N is making or not. But if I bid 3♥ (natural and forcing 1-round) then partner will likely rebid 3N or 4♣ and this will not help me – I would love to be able to Keycard in ♥. I decided that I would take a simple tact. I would just keycard in ♣ now (bid 4N) and if partner had only one keycard I would bid 7♥.

Today, partner came through for me. He showed 2 Keycards without the Queen of ♣. That meant that I had discards for both of my losers as long as I could get to the dummy. It seemed reasonable that partner might have as little as the ♦K, ♠Q, ♥J, or even possibly ♥7x that could allow me an entry to the dummy. Since I knew that partner had at most ♣AKJ (8 of his 10-15 points), that meant he was very likely to have some outside card to get me to the dummy (if he had answered 5♠ showing ♣AKQ+ I would have been more concerned.)

So I took the chance and decided that the *Matchpoint Greed* was worth it. Partner put down just what I was hoping for and 7N making 13 tricks for +2220 was a great result!
