## SWEET SUCCESS IN THE SWISS

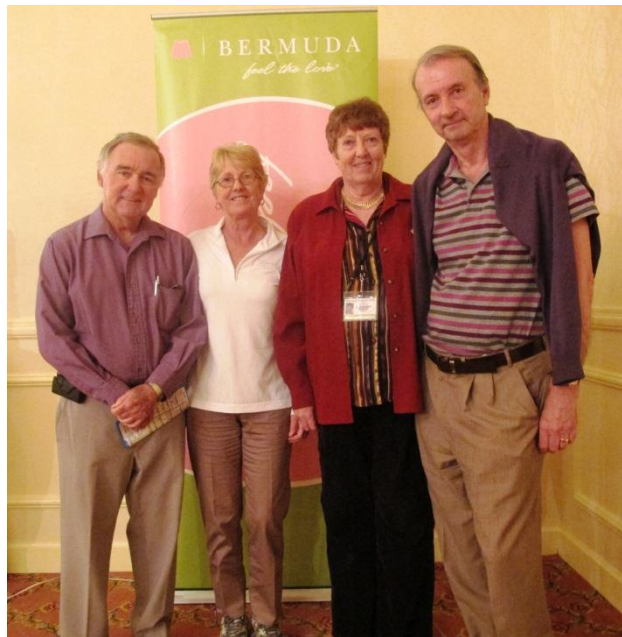

# YESTERDAY'S BEST

### 8-card Suit, Not Trump?!?

My partner faced a series of difficult decisions on this deal from the Finals of the Bracket 1 KO. My RHO opened the bidding with 1♣ and I had 6-5 hand. I overcalled a simple 1♦ (on my great 6-card suit) and my LHO bid 1♥. My Partner (Adam Kaplan) was now faced with a horrible choice. What to do when your opponent bids your 8-card suit? *Not the kind of problem that one is faced with everyday...*

Adam considered bidding Pass, X, 1♠, 2♥, or even more ♥. All of them seem reasonable in their own strange ways – but the problem was to figure out what each of these calls shows and how to continue after bidding them. Adam decided to start with a pass – figuring that he would get to come back in later.

Now, my RHO bid 2♣ and I bid 2♠ (showing my hand) and LHO bid 3♣. Adam suddenly faced a new problem that he did not expect. How to raise partner and show an 8-card side suit at the same time? He jumped to 4♥ and hoped that I would figure out that he had both ♥ and ♠ (at least I think that's what he was trying to do.) I was in the tank (I actually had my head on the table for about 3 minutes) trying to figure out how my partner could have done this to me – this is a problem I couldn't have dreamed of facing when this action started. My general rule is that when I'm not sure what to do then the last thing I want to do is Pass but after much consideration I decided that partner could make 4♥ and I should let him play it there.

When dummy appeared, partner saw that he had a ♣ loser, 2♥, and a ♠ loser. We had chosen the wrong game to play. But after ruffing the second round of ♣ he saw a way that we might survive. He led a low ♠ to dummy's Jack, sneaking it past the Opening bidder. This allowed him the entry to dummy that he was desperate to find. He now discarded all three of his remaining ♠ on the ♦AKQ. That was now only 3 losers for +420! *Whew, we survived that one!*

***Auction Analysis:***

As North, I made an imperfect negative double -- I'd like to be in this auction, and playing in a 4-3 spade fit wouldn't be the end of the world here. My partner, Bill Tucker, bid 3NT, which ended the auction.

***Play Notes:***

West's choice of the S9 was interesting: They didn't want to concede a diamond to South's marked diamond king, so they tried to find an entry into partner's hand to lead a diamond through. With their lack of entries it's quite a reasonable shot, and, if nothing else, may avoid giving up a trick.

After winning the opening lead in hand, Bill played the HA, and ducked a round of hearts, which East won, and returned another spade which was won in dummy. Next came the HK, bringing down the remaining heart honours from the opponents, with Bill pitching a low club from his hand. Now came two more hearts, pitching two more low clubs from his hand, taking care to keep three diamonds to the king. On these hearts, East pitched a spade and a club, and West pitched a couple of diamonds. At this point, there are three spade tricks, four heart tricks and at least a club trick. West had shown two spades, three hearts, and was known to have 6 diamonds, meaning that West was not likely to hold the CK, especially since they are known to hold the HQ and DAQJ. Bill now played a club to the queen holding the trick, and the CA, with everyone following to both clubs. West was now reduced to all diamonds, and when Bill cashed the SQ and exited a diamond, West was end-played to concede a diamond at trick 13... Bill's 10th trick was the card that poor West had so desperately been trying to avoid letting him score. Plus 630 was worth 22 and a half on a 23 top, which helped our win in the two-session open pairs tonight!

I also won the Championship KO today with Robert Todd, Patty Herlihy, Theri Andino and Adam Parrish. It's been a fun week, and I'll be back next year to defend both titles!
